

**Wastewater Treatment Operator

The South Central Wastewater Authority is accepting applications for a Wastewater Treatment Operator. Applicants must have at the minimum a high school diploma or GED. Responsibilities include troubleshooting operations and maintenance problems, performing special tests, measurements, laboratory analysis, mathematical calculations and recording data on standard log sheets and/or computerized spreadsheets. Performs general maintenance, grounds keeping, and housekeeping activities as assigned. This position requires working a 12 hour rotating shift including some holidays and weekends. Must present valid Driver’s License & satisfactory DMV record prior to start of interview. Subject to pre-employment physical, drug screen, and criminal background check. Class I or II Wastewater License preferred, consideration will be given to Class III, IV and Trainee. If hired as a trainee, must obtain a Virginia Class IV Wastewater Operators License w/in 1 ½ years of employment.
